

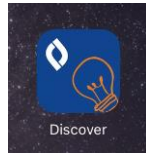

Using Apps - *Draft*

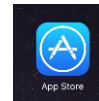
ABOUT: You can view our district's ebook & audio book collections on a portable device (ipad, iphone etc.), using a **browser**. Another tip sheet has been created for this. You can also view them on a portable device by downloading two **apps**:



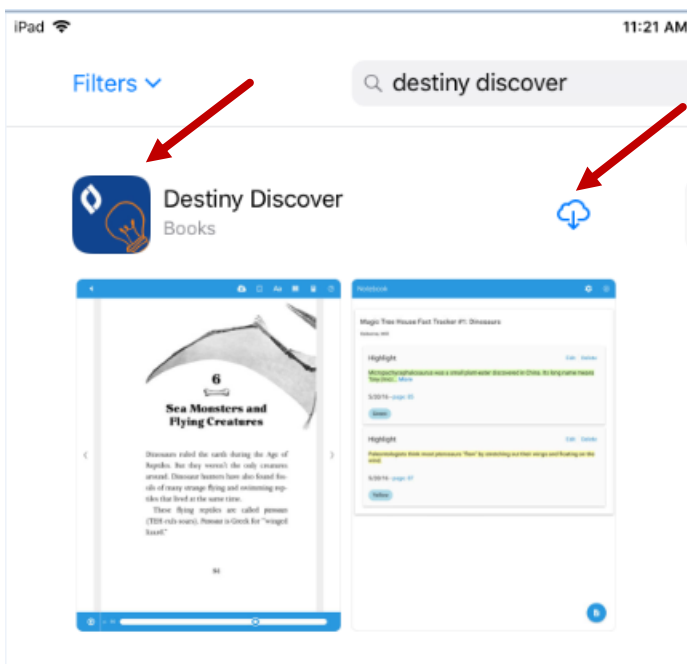
Destiny Discover



Overdrive



To install the **Destiny Discover** app, go to the App Store on your ipad. In the search bar, enter **Destiny Discover** and tap on **Search**. The app you want to download is the one by Follett Sochol Solutions:




Click on the download icon to download it:


Once downloaded, click **OPEN**. The login screen

appears. For **Location**, scroll down to the bottom of the location menu and tap on **British Columbia**.

For the **Schools in British Columbia**, start typing your school name. When it appears, tap on it. For this example, I started typing in Arden:

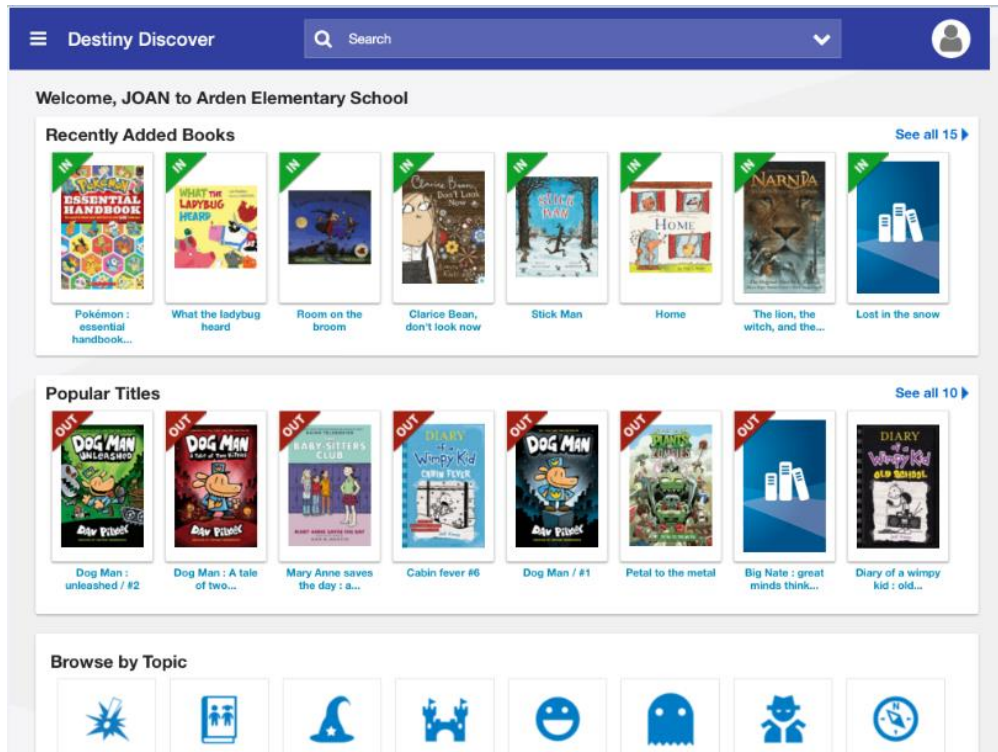

Then click on **Login**. The “Log in using your Follett account” screen appears:

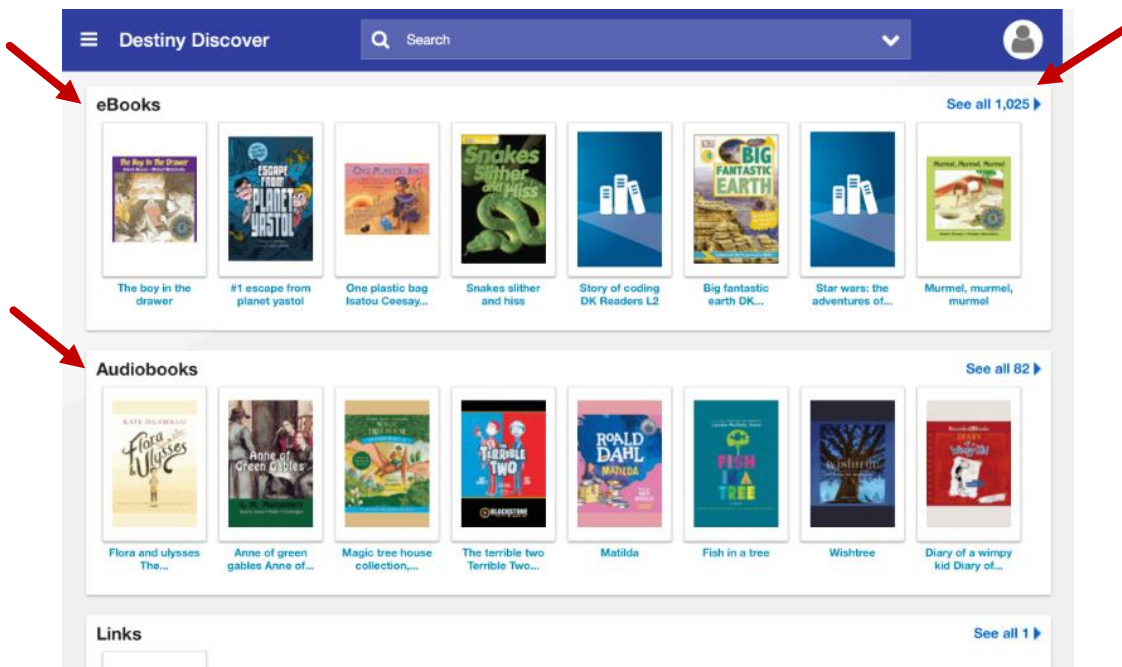

Fill the same username and password that you use to sign into your school library. I typed mine in and tapped on **Submit**. The **Destiny Discover** page for Arden appears:



Scroll down and the ribbons for ebooks and audio books display:

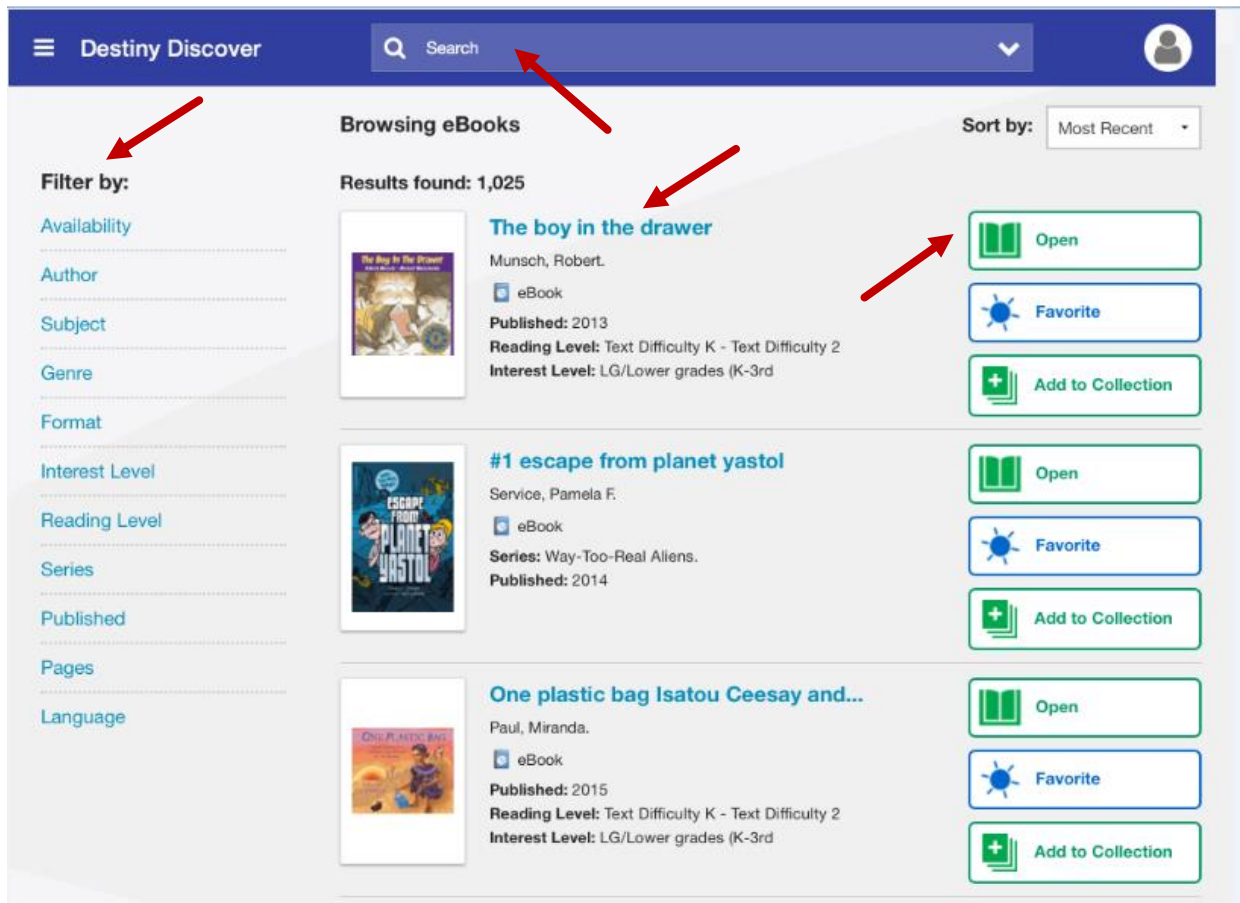

You can either do a search, by scrolling up and typing your search term in the blue search bar,





or you can click on “See all X” in the ebook or audio book ribbons, to have all of the titles displayed. In this example, I tapped on “See all X” in the ebook ribbon and this screen appears:

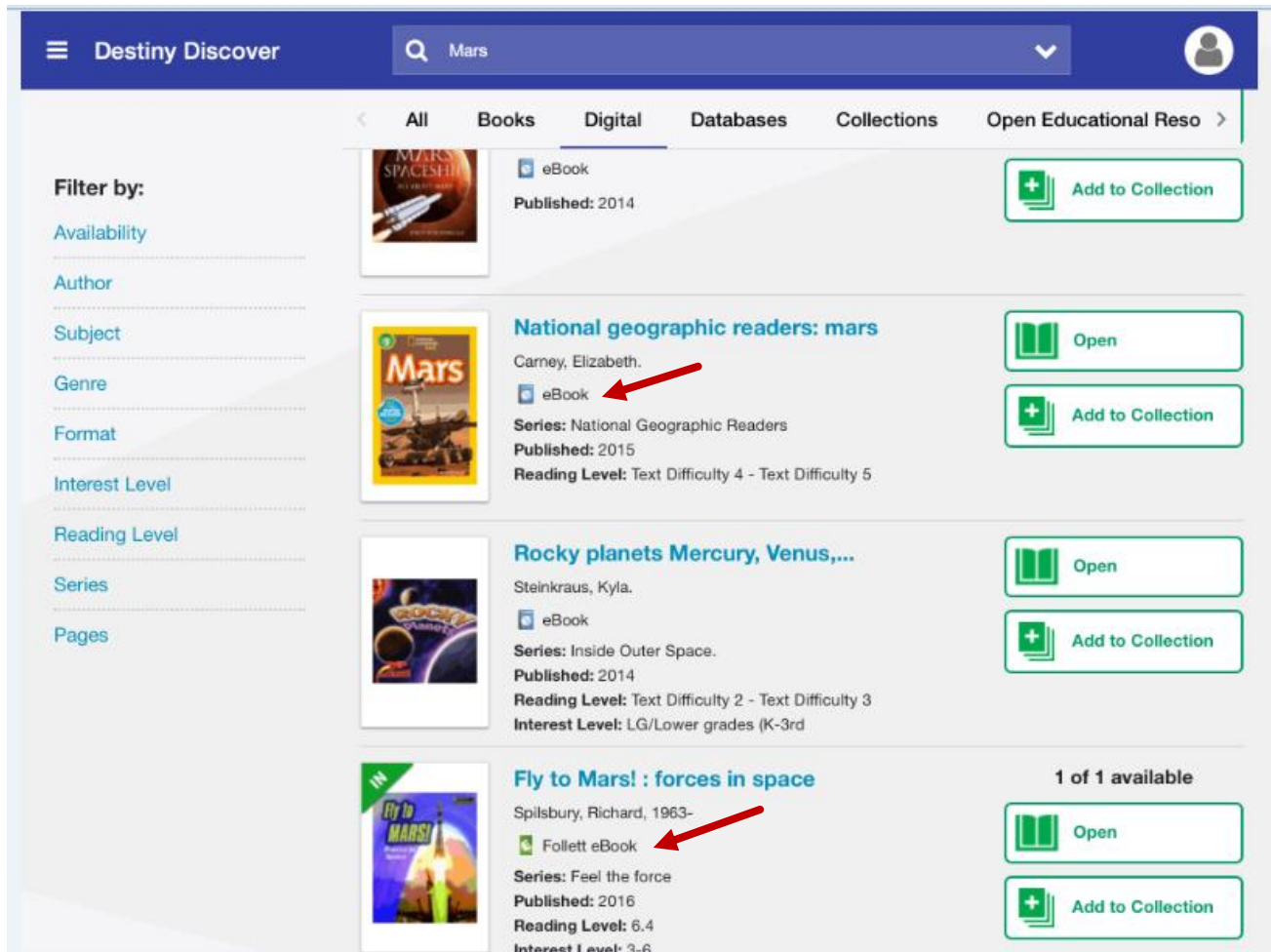


From this screen you have a variety of options. You can:

- Do a search for a specific topic by typing your topic in in the search bar.
- Filter your search by choosing the options in the Filter menu.
- Scroll down to browse titles.
- Click on a specific title to learn more about it, such as whether it has a mechanical text to speech option or not.
- Click on OPEN beside a title.

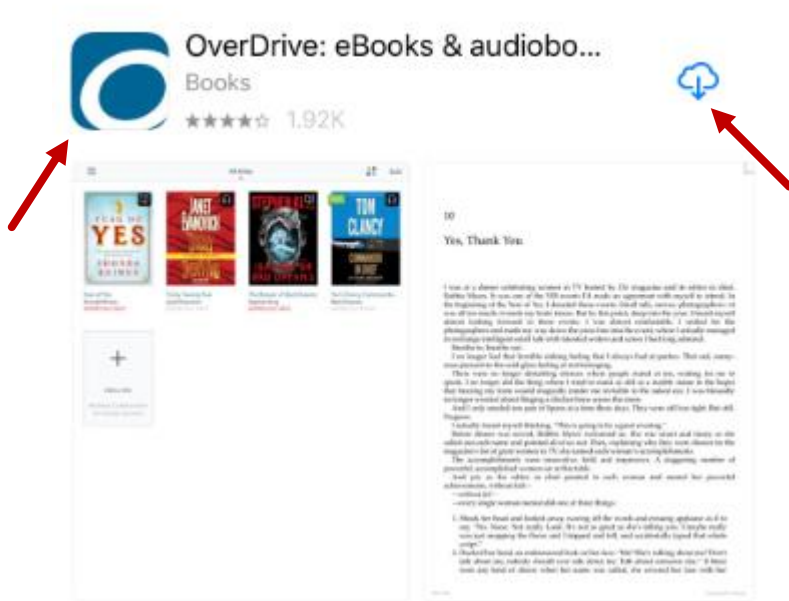
In this example, I typed in “mars” in the search bar, then tapped **Search**. Ten titles appeared, some of them being Follett ebooks, identified by the green e symbol , and others being Overdrive ebooks, identified by the blue e symbol .



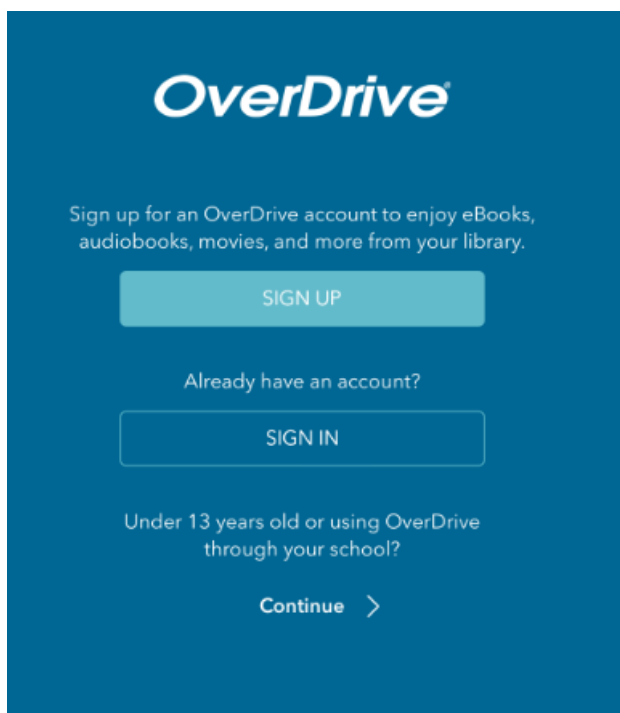
Try opening an ebook to explore the variety of tools available, as well as how to sign them out. Specific instructions on this can be found in the help sheet “Accessing ebooks & Audio books Through a Catalog Destiny Discover Search in a Browser on a Computer or ipad” found in *learn71.ca* (Library Learning Commons) or through “Help Sheets” on your school’s library landing page.

To download the Overdrive app, go to the App store. In the search bar type in “Overdrive.” The app you want is called “OverDrive: eBooks & audiobo...” See below:




Click on the download cloud to download it, then **OPEN** to open it. This screen appears:

An OverDrive account syncs your progress through titles, your saved libraries, and your bookmarks across multiple devices.

Use your OverDrive account to sign into the OverDrive app, overdrive.com, and new OverDrive library websites. Make sure you always sign in using the same method, especially if you plan to download eBooks to the OverDrive app ([learn more here](#)).





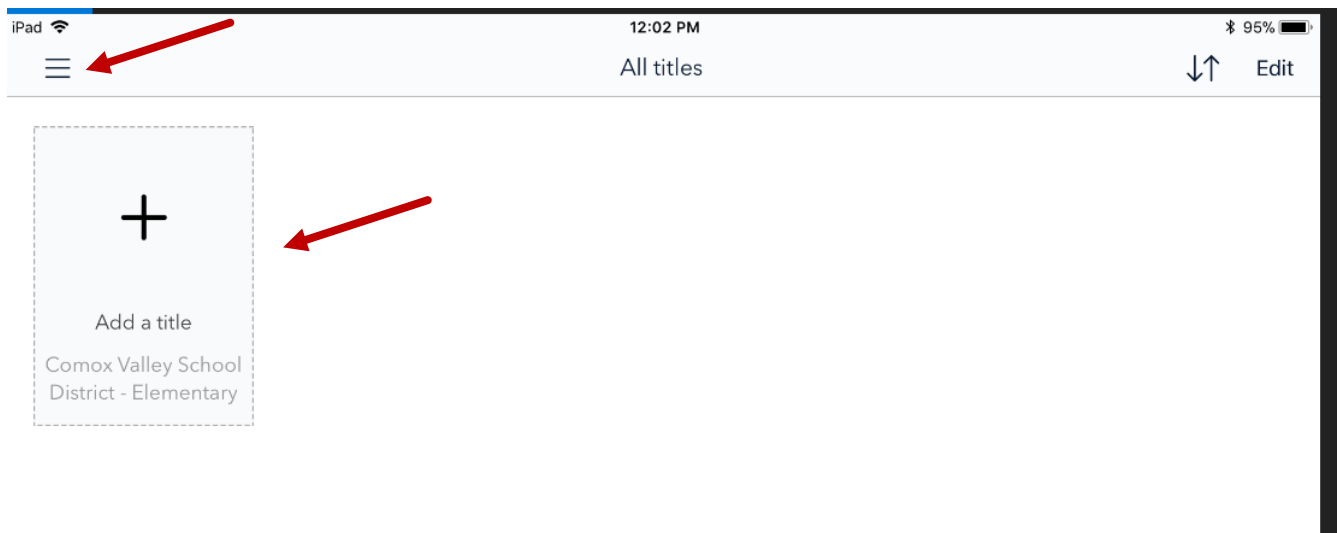

Click on **Sign In**. The SD71 Follett account login appears:



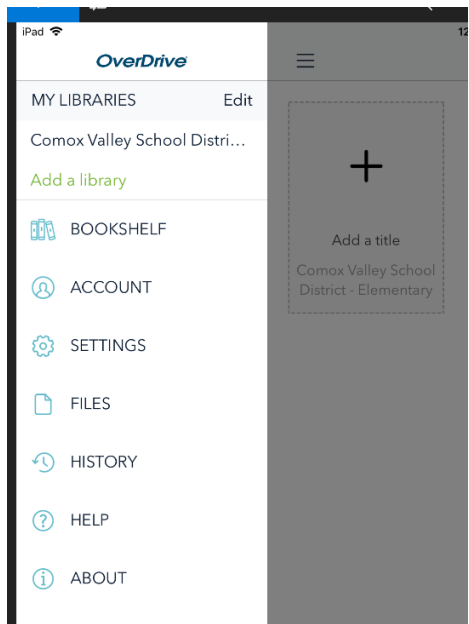

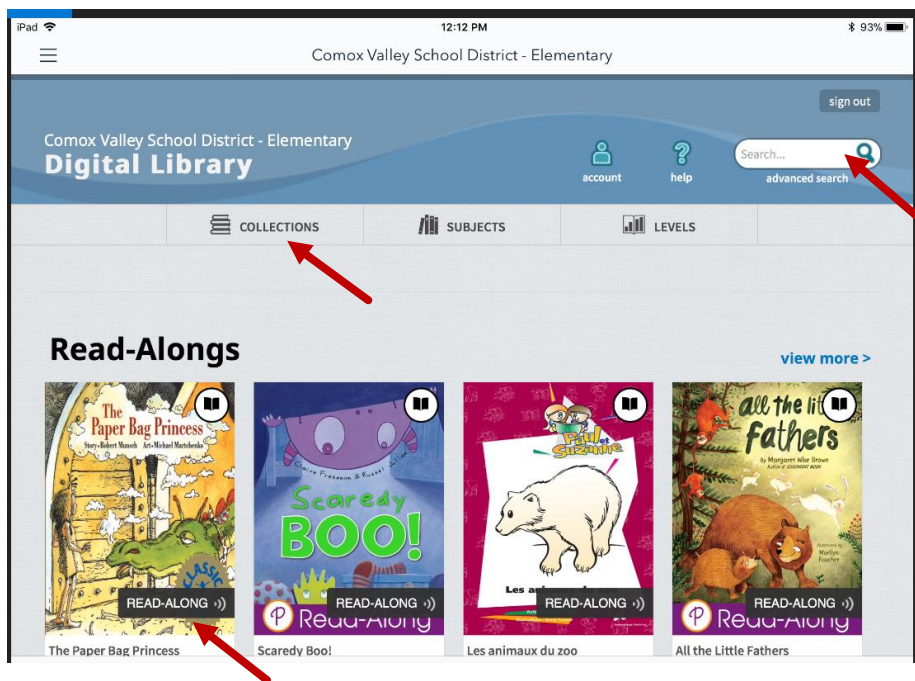
Click on the hamburger  to get a menu of your account:

From this screen you can tap on a book to borrow and open it, or you can search for a specific subject by filling in the search bar. More information on the tools available with Overdrive ebooks etc., can be found in the help sheet “Accessing ebooks & Audio books Through a Catalog Destiny Discover Search in a Browser on a Computer or ipad” in *learn71.ca* (Library Commons) or through “Help Sheets” on your school’s library landing page.

Addition info or advice:

Once the apps are installed, you will not need to set them up again. To access your school library collection and ebooks/audio books, simply tap on the Destiny Quest app icon or the Destiny Discover app icon. Note that only our Overdrive ebooks and audio books are available through the Overdrive App, whereas both Follett and Overdrive ebooks and audio books are available through the Destiny Quest App. If you are looking solely for professionally narrated ebooks, then the Overdrive app would be the quickest way to find them as only the Overdrive ebook collection has some professionally narrated titles. Some of the Follett titles, however, have some computerized text to speech. To find out which titles do, you have to click on the title.
